The International Workshop on Peer-to-Peer Systems (IPTPS) aimed to provide a forum for researchers active in peer-to-peer computing to discuss the state of the art and to identify key research challenges. The goal of the workshop was to examine peer-to-peer technologies, applications, and systems, and also to identify key research issues and challenges that lie ahead. In the context of this workshop, peer-to-peer systems were characterized as being decentralized, self-organizing distributed systems, in which all or most communication is symmetric. The program of the workshop was a combination of invited talks, presentations of position papers, and discussions covering novel peer-to-peer applications and systems, peer-to-peer infrastructure, security in peer-to-peer systems, anonymity and anti-censorship, performance of peer-to-peer systems, and workload characterization for peer-to-peer systems. To ensure a productive workshop environment, attendance was limited to 55 participants. Each

potential participant was asked to submit a position paper of 5 pages that exposed a new problem, advocated a specific solution, or reported on actual experience. We received 99 submissions and were able to accept 31.

Participants were invited based on the originality, technical merit, and topical relevance of their submissions, as well as the likelihood that the ideas expressed in their submissions would lead to insightful technical discussions at the workshop.

Of course, that only made her impact with the ground that much more devastating. *Bad Things* is about Tristan and Danika, and their train wreck of a love story. This series can be read as a standalone, or with the *Up in the Air* trilogy. This book is intended for ages 18 and up.
